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#### EVIDENCE BASED CURED CASE OF GALL BLADDER CANCER

Currently in India almost one million new cancer cases are diagnosed yearly. Conventional medicine including chemotherapy and radiotherapy has variable results but many adverse effects that limit their use. Now for various reasons cancer patients are choosing alternative medicines, mainly homoeopathy.

Reviewing the classical literatures it is observed that most of the homoeopathic treatments are aimed at palliating the adverse effects of chemo & radiotherapy and a very few cases are published indicating treatment of cancer cases directly. From the authors practice it is observed that homoeopathy prescribed according to its principle reverse the cancer pathology in very early diagnosed cases.

In this presentation, a Gall bladder cancer was treated which occurred due to complication of long standing gall bladder stone being untreated. The case was diagnosed by ultrasound, C.T. scan and confirmed by FNAC. The peculiar symptoms were cheerfulness, in spite of suffering, dominating even if illiterate in her family, very active in both mental and physical spheres, irritable to even slight contradiction, fear of crowd and mental tension. As all these are prominent symptoms of Lachesis, it was prescribed in millesimal scale.

Only pain subsided but no further improvement occurred and during the subsequent interview it was observed that though the patient was dominating in the family, she was very much afraid of crowd, and lack of confidence outside the house while managing other household affairs. Lycopodium was prescribed which reduced pain and improved appetite and weakness. But there was intermittent recurrence of pain.

Observing mental tension, fear of crowd, very active, irritable and deep acting indicated drugs like Lachesis, Lycopodium partially ameliorating, Morgan gartner, a deep acting bowel nosode which has symptoms of both Lachesis and Lycopodium was prescribed in 10M potency. After Morgan gartner, there was no pain and appetite and general wellbeing were much better.

Ultrasound was advised which confirmed, metastasis to liver, infiltration to stomach and mass in gall bladder were not found. On FNAC, no cancer cells were found in the gall bladder and stones were left behind. The patient is still alive along with gall bladder stones because she left the treatment in 2005. The patient again consulted the author in 2009 for the pain in abdomen. Ultrasound of abdomen revealed no recurrence of mass and the stones were as in 2005. It is a classical cure, consistent with Herring's Law of Cure.
